



ACS CAN Pride Event Posters – Printing Information

There are three Pride event poster designs for use at Pride events. The art files provided are high-resolution, print-quality art in a PDF format. When you take the art to a printer to produce the posters, you may be asked certain questions. Use the information below to help answer the printer's questions and to get the best results.

- Three poster designs – art for all three posters is in one PDF file.
- All art is high-resolution, print-quality art in PDF format.
- All posters are sized at 22” wide by 28” tall (vertical format).
- The posters are to be printed and mounted on 3/8” or thicker foam core board or 1/4” or thicker Coroplast (best for outdoors).
- The art was produced in four-color process – no PMS matches required.
- Each poster design “bleeds” 4 sides (design runs all the way to the edge on all 4 sides).
- Two different art files are provided for printing posters – one with crop marks and one without.
- Some printers use crop marks as guides to trim the posters to size.
- If the printer asks for art with crop marks, provide the file named **ACS CAN Pride Posters Full Bleed w Crops.pdf**
- When in doubt, or if the printer does not specifically ask for crop marks, provide the alternate file that **does not have crop marks** named **ACS CAN Pride Posters Full Bleed No Crops.pdf**

ACS CAN Pride Handouts

Handouts are also provided for your event. They include the same information as the posters but have a different design. All three handouts are included in one PDF file. These may be printed desktop or taken to a local Fedex, UPS or Staples store to run color (digital) copies in high quantities.

- All 3 handouts are in the same PDF file.
- Handouts are a standard 8.5” x 11” size.
- All art is high-resolution, print-quality art in PDF format.
- Each handout is a single-sided sheet.
