

Discussion Guide: Faith Groups

This supplemental discussion guide provides suggested questions to use with communities of faith at screenings of ACS CAN's short films: *Critical Condition: Stories of Health in the Heartland; On the Edge: Health Care in Alabama* or *Left Behind: Health and Hope in North Carolina*. - 1. Was there a story that resonated with you most, or that you related to most?
 Why?
- 2. How does our faith inform our view on health care?
 - a. Is there a moral argument for access to health care?
- 3. How important is access to care to the well-being of our community?
- 4. How many of our community members are without health care insurance?
- 5. Have you worked with individuals who are uninsured?
 - a. How did that impact them, their families, and their community?
 - b. How does it affect your ability to connect them with the care and services they need?
- 6. How do we help connect members of our community to health care services?
- 7. Are we doing enough to support our neighbors and fellow [state residents]?
 - a. If not, what is the personal and societal cost of that?
 - b. What more can/should we do? (educate, advocate)
- 8. How can we help educate the public and legislators on the importance of health care to members of our community?
